



BOAT RENTAL RULES OF THE ROAD

ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING IN BOATHOUSE

OPERATING RULES

- Watch safety video at FLBC before venturing out.
- Two “NO GO” zones: 1) The boat shall NOT BE OPERATED IN THE AREA SOUTH AND TO THE WEST (to the left as you head north out into the lake) OF THE RED LIGHTHOUSE, even if you see other boats in the prohibited area, because there is a submerged concrete wall. 2) The area within ½ mile of Stewart Park is littered with snags, trees and very shallow spots. Do Not attempt to beach at Stewart Park. CUSTOMER IS 100% LIABLE FOR ANY PROPERTY DAMAGE, PERSONAL INJURY AND LOSS OF LIFE FOR TRAVELING IN THE “NO GO” zones.
- The Cayuga Inlet all the way out to the red lighthouse is a No Wake Zone which means go slow and don't create a wake.
- Prohibitions against drinking alcohol and/or consuming drugs apply to boating just the same as they do to driving. Boating accidents do happen and the lake may be patrolled – Be Responsible.
- You will give way to ALL boats under sail or powered by humans at all times. You will allow all oncoming boats to go by you to the left. You shall follow the Rules of the Road chart provided on Board.
- Channel 16 is for emergency purposes only.
- When returning please radio FLBC on channel 16 as soon as you enter the Cayuga Inlet (White Light House). When we respond you will be asked to switch to a different channel. This will alert FLBC staff so they can assist in returning boat into the boathouse. If radio communication fails you may call 607-272-9227.

GASOLINE

- You will start off with a full tank (22 gallons) and we will re-fill at the end of the rental and you will be charged the per gallon market rate or you may fill it at Johnsons marina. Filling from your own gas container is not allowed.

SAFETY GEAR

- Boat Capacity is 12 persons or 1,660 pounds.
- We provide throw cushions, fire extinguisher, a VHF radio, horn and flares and anchor & line. These are not to be used for any purposes other than in the event of an emergency;
- Any equipment misused will have to be paid for in full. We provide safety equipment for pontoons with the exception of infant vests.
- Life Vests are provided on board and are recommended to be worn at all times.
- Children under the age of eight must wear a life vest at all times.
- We do not allow cooking/grilling on the pontoons.

AGE LIMIT

- You must be at least 21 years of age to rent/drive rentals with valid driver's license.

PETS

- Sorry, no pets allowed.

CLEANLINESS

- Any boats returned extremely muddy, dirty, with food bits and trash strewn about will be subject to an additional \$45 cleaning charge.
- Fishing is not allowed. Any sign of having fished will result in a charge of \$150.00.

WEATHER

- Keep a weather eye out. The VHF radio has a weather channel on it. Storms can come up quickly and unexpectedly and even from the opposite direction of the current wind. When in doubt, seek shelter by the shore.
